Aims and objectives

Our Boogie Bear French language programme is suitable for children aged 2-5 years old. In level 1, we aim to teach children, basic nouns and grammar as to enhance communication, and pronunciation. Children will also be learning through music and will use musical instruments to practice beat, rhythm and sequencing.
